Minutes:

• Remaining budget for 2022. Kim had said approximately \$10,000 and we'd like to confirm that. UPDATE: Debby spoke with Kim and the budget is approximately \$7,000-\$10,000 for the remainder of 2022. It would be best to stay closer to the \$7,000 budget as costs are going up in other areas. Mulch is a separate budget.

- Berm:
  - o Clean up trimming, removing volunteer trees
    - Trimming completed in July and more aggressive trimming will be done in the fall.
    - Need an estimate on removal of volunteer trees
  - Strategic planting short term and long term
    - Short term Do a volunteer day to clean up/remove weeds. Get estimates for new mulch, removing volunteer trees and some replacement plants
    - Long term Need to re-survey and mark property line. Ensure we are considering what makes sense to add value to the whole Diamonte community. Schedule a meeting for September timeframe with LC, Board and other interested homeowners to discuss long term plans.
  - Mulch get estimate (include the monument areas). Total Turf suggested doing in the Spring to be "fresh" for the season.
  - Edging get estimate
  - o Bird feeders determine if these should be removed from the berm

## Non-Berm

- New plants and sustainability of non-hearty perennials (soil and watering)
  - LC needs to re-visit some of the perennial choices. Some are not doing well due to soil conditions and some due to lack of watering.
  - Suggestion made to have anchor plants (arborvitaes, ornamental tree, etc.) be
    the responsibility of the HOA and other plants become the responsibility of
    homeowners based upon an approved list and board approval around
    design/placement. This requires Premier input and changes to the rules and
    regulations.
  - Debby suggested members from the LC meet with the Lakepoint LC to discuss their guidelines and current issues. Debby to provide Deb with a contact.
- Planting new plants need to factor in costs for new soil
  - All agreed that new soil needs to be part of costs for new plants
- When to plant (spring, summer, fall)
- Homeowner communications (through Premier)
  - Debby to follow up with Premier on specific concerns LC had around watering, pet damage, lights in bushes and ensure they send out emails to homeowners.
  - Board/Premier to follow up with homeowners who sent in landscaping concerns/issues. Debby took a copy of those items.
  - Margaret to send out a reminder email to all homeowners to water. COMPLETE.

## **NEXT STEPS:**

- Schedule a second meeting (1.5 hours) with LC and Board to for further discussion focused on foundation plantings. Deb to coordinate. Tentatively scheduled for 7/20.
- Request estimates on mulch, edging, removal of volunteer trees, replacement plants. Work out details at next meeting.
- Debby to send Deb a contact from the Lakepoint LC association.
- Schedule a berm cleanup day. Need someone to lead this from the LC.
- Board to follow up with Premier on the suggestion to have responsibility of some plants be HOA and some be homeowners.
